

CONSUMER PROTECTION

Sanitarian Services

- ⇒ *Agent for Wisconsin Division of Health.* Services provided include inspection, education, and code enforcement of restaurants, lodging facilities/bed and breakfast establishments, public pools/recreational areas, and vending machines.
- ⇒ *Agent for Wisconsin Department of Agriculture* which includes inspection of retail food stores and follow-up of consumer complaints and food recalls.
- ⇒ Indoor and outdoor air quality control.
- ⇒ Performs lead risk inspections and assessments.
- ⇒ Follows-up on environmental complaints and hazards.

Weights and Measures Program

The Neenah Department of Public Health Weights and Measures Program protects the consumer by ensuring fair and accurate product sales. These services include:

- ⇒ Investigation of consumer complaints
- ⇒ Scale testing at supermarkets, farmer's markets, bakery and candy stores, hardware stores, pet stores, recyclers, and other retail stores

Weights and Measures Program

- ⇒ Gas pumps and oil meter testing at fuel oil distributors
- ⇒ Scanner testing at food and other retail stores
- ⇒ Checking the accuracy of weights listed on product labels in compliance with State and Federal regulations
- ⇒ Issues weights and measures licenses to retail businesses

DISEASE PREVENTION

Immunizations

- ⇒ Monthly immunization clinics for routine childhood vaccines. Call for an appointment.
- ⇒ Adult Td (Tetanus)

Communicable Disease

Health education regarding prevention and treatment of:

- ⇒ Vaccine preventable diseases
- ⇒ Food and water borne illness
- ⇒ Tuberculosis
- ⇒ Sexually Transmitted Disease

Lead Poisoning

- ⇒ Health Education
- ⇒ Follow-up of elevated blood lead levels
- ⇒ Screening of home environment

Rabies Control

- ⇒ Follow-up of human and animal exposure

Parent and Child Health

Parent and child health services focus on promoting healthy families. Services are provided in the home or by telephone.

Services include:

- ⇒ Assessment, health education, and guidance related to:
 - Pregnancy
 - Mom and baby care
 - Infant and child growth and development
 - Nutrition
 - Parenting
- ⇒ Coordination and referrals to other community agencies as needed

Adult Health

Adult health services focus on promotion of a healthy lifestyle. Services are provided in the home, at the Neenah Department of Public Health, or by telephone. Services include:

- ⇒ Assessment, health education, and guidance related to:
 - Healthy living
 - Nutrition
 - Safety
 - Emotional well-being
 - Short and long term illness
 - Medication monitoring
 - Blood pressure screening

School Health Services

The Neenah Department of Public Health provides student health services under contract with the Neenah Joint School District.

Services in the schools include but are not limited to: vision, hearing, and scoliosis screening; participation in Pupil Personnel Committee Meetings, Individual Educational Plan (IEPs), Crisis Team Interventions; State Immunization Law compliance audit; school-based immunization clinics.
