- League play will be in the Shattuck Middle School **OJ Gym**, 600 Elm Street, Neenah on Wednesday evenings beginning Jan. 27 with a practice. Enter the gym through the East school entrance. Park in designated marked stalls.
- Each team will play 8 matches-everyone plays everyone twice. Match starting times are 7:00, 8:00 and some 9:00 PM, due to the byes. Home team has serve in first and third games and away team has choice of side for first and third games.
- There is NO GRACE PERIOD-be on time for the start of your match.
- The net will be put up & taken down by my volleyball official. He will also set out shuttlecocks and a score sheet.
- Keep track of your score. The server should call out points with their team's score called first.
- After each game, mark your score on the provided score sheet. The volleyball official will pick up the score sheet at the end of the evening, along with the shuttlecocks.
- First team to reach 21 pts wins. No win by 2. Rally scoring will be used. (Points awarded after each fault, regardless if serving.) Each game counts. A play-off will be played at the end of the season for first place ties only. Team with the best win-loss game record wins the league. First place receives individual league championship t-shirts and a team plaque.
- Children are not allowed in the gym. If absolutely necessary, they must be accompanied by an adult and sitting along the sidelines. This is not an open gym for children to run around – it is for their own safety.
- Warm-ups: Teams should NOT warm-up in the hallways. Please begin warm-ups, prior to getting on the court. Be ready to start play, as soon as the previous match has been completed or by 7:00 PM, if scheduled as the first match of the evening.
- Cancellations - our office will not call team managers, if games are cancelled. If school is called off, games probably will be called, but not always.
