Re: Stolen Charity Money from McDonalds

On August 29 several teenage boys cashed in a large quantity of coins at the automatic coin machine inside the store. Several store employees overheard some of the conversation between the juveniles that made reference to stealing the coins from McDonalds.

The Police were called and it was determined that the juveniles had indeed stolen a coin box from McDonalds on Bell Street earlier in the evening. The boxes are placed on the counter for customer donations to McDonald's charities.

Officers reviewed surveillance tape from Pick N Save and were able to determine some of the suspect's identities from prior police contacts. Four male suspects were subsequently interviewed and arrested for the theft of the charitable donations and the donation box.

The donation box was recovered behind a local business and the four teenagers, two at age 14, one at 15 and the last at 17 were referred to the District Attorney on theft charges.
