Re: Investigation of Attempted Homicide

The Neenah Police Department is currently conducting an investigation of an Attempted Homicide that occurred at approximately 6:25 a.m. this morning, in the 200 Block of Joseph Court.

Preliminary investigation has determined that a lone male driver attempted to run down another adult male with the driver's vehicle. The male victim managed to avoid being hit with only a minor injury to his leg. In the process of trying to run down the victim, the driver of the car smashed at least twice into a parked vehicle and at least once into an apartment building.

Police units arrived within a minute of the initial call and they were able to take the male driver into custody, and disarm the victim, who was at that point, advancing on the driver with a section of a pool cue.

At this time the Neenah Police Department is processing the scene; there is a great deal of physical evidence and witness statements to gather reference this complaint. The driver has been arrested and will be referred to the Winnebago County District Attorney's Office for charges of Reckless Endangerment and Attempted Homicide.
