Leave medication in the original package or prescription bottle. Cross out your name and address, but D0 N0T cover up the name of the medication.



DO DROP THESE ITEMS

- Expired and Unused Medications
- **Over-the-Counter Medications**
- **Medication Samples**
- **Pet Medications**
- Medicated Ointment/Lotion/Drops

DON'T DROP THESE ITEMS

- Inhalers
- **Unopened Epi-Pens**
- **Liquid Medications**

Hydrogen Peroxide

Empty Containers

IV Bags

Needles/Lancets/Syringes

Bloody or Infectious Waste

Business Waste (Nursing/group homes, etc)

Personal Care Products (shampoo, etc)







NEVER flush medications down the toilet!

Medications flushed down the toilet are ending up in our drinking water. Water treatment facilities are not designed to remove medications. Medications are also affecting fish and other aquatic life after treatment facilities return the water to streams and rivers.

Also, don't throw medicines into the trash! Medications can leak into groundwater from lined landfills.
