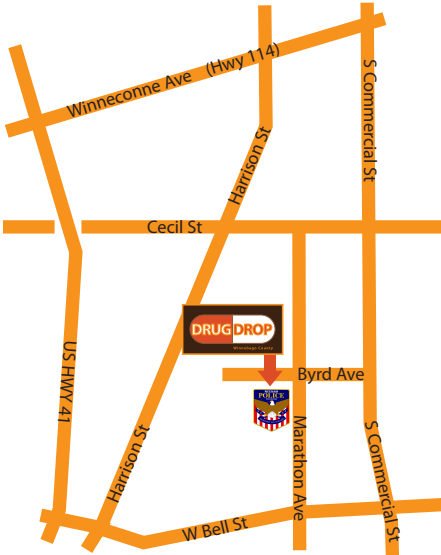


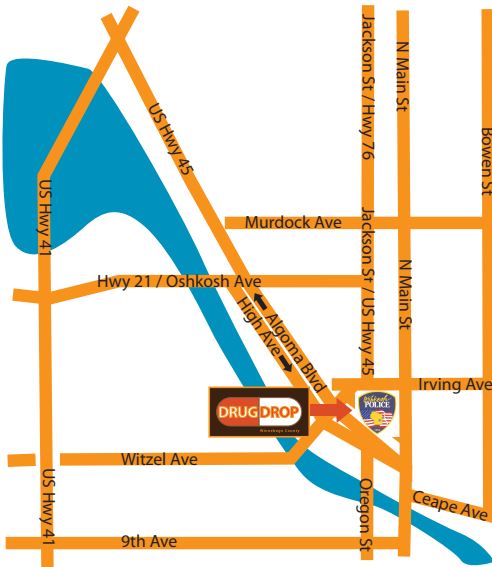

# WHAT TO DROP

Leave medication in the original package or prescription bottle. Cross out your name and address, but DO NOT cover up the name of the medication.



## DO DROP THESE ITEMS

Expired and Unused Medications  
Over-the-Counter Medications  
Medication Samples  
Pet Medications  
Medicated Ointment/Lotion/Drops  
Inhalers  
Unopened Epi-Pens  
Liquid Medications



## DON'T DROP THESE ITEMS

Needles/Lancets/Syringes  
Thermometers  
IV Bags  
Bloody or Infectious Waste  
Hydrogen Peroxide  
Business Waste (Nursing/group homes, etc)  
Empty Containers  
Personal Care Products (shampoo, etc)



## NEVER flush medications down the toilet!

Medications flushed down the toilet are ending up in our drinking water. Water treatment facilities are not designed to remove medications. Medications are also affecting fish and other aquatic life after treatment facilities return the water to streams and rivers.

Also, don't throw medicines into the trash! Medications can leak into groundwater from lined landfills.
