**Re: Additional Details on Child Death**

Neenah Police issued a press release on February 14 regarding the death of a 2-year-old child the previous day. The child had been transported by Gold Cross Ambulance from a home on Marathon Avenue to Theda Care Medical Center – Neenah. He was pronounced dead at 4:10 p.m. The original call to police was received at 2:43 p.m.

An autopsy was performed on February 14 at the UW Hospital in Madison. The autopsy revealed no signs of trauma or other unusual circumstances. The investigation will remain active pending toxicology results, which are expected in 4 – 6 weeks.

The child and his parents are Neenah residents. He was being cared for in the home of a family member, also in Neenah, on the day of the death. The Neenah Police Department is not releasing the name of the child or his family at this time.

It is unusual for a child to die in the home, and it is always tragic. The Neenah Police Department asks that the community's thoughts and prayers be with the family and others whose hearts have been broken by this loss.
