**Date: April 15, 2015**

**Re: Assist – Person in Water**

At about 2:48 a.m., on April 15, 2015, Winnebago County 911 Center dispatched a call of a distressed person in the water of Little Lake Butte des Morts, west from the end of High Street. The waters of the lake are within the jurisdiction of the Winnebago County Sheriff's Office.

Neenah officers responded and learned from a witness that the subject had been calling for help from a location 100-200 feet from shore. Prior to officers' arrival, the calls for help had ended and the man was not visible. The witness believed the subject was now submerged.

Officers used a spotlight to locate the probable location of the man. Two Neenah officers then removed their gear and went out into the lake and located the man, who was submerged. The water at that point was about chest deep. The officers dragged the man back near shore where other officers assisted and initiated CPR.

The subject was transported from the scene by ambulance.

Because this case is in the jurisdiction of the Winnebago County Sheriff's Office, the Neenah Police Department will not be releasing any information about the status or identity of the subject pulled from the lake.
