Re: Heroin-related home invasion/robbery

On Sunday, June 1, Neenah officers responded to a call of suspicious circumstances in the 600 block of Maple Street. Police were advised that two males were seen fleeing a residence with bandanas covering their faces. Through investigation, officers learned that two suspects had broken into an occupied home and attacked the 41-year-old female occupant. The intruders were looking for money and drugs, and they beat the occupant with some type of bat or pipe while demanding to be told where the items were.

After stealing cash, the suspects fled in opposite directions on foot.

One of the suspects was located in the area and taken into custody. The other was found hours later after he had apparently overdosed on heroin in an apartment stairwell on Adams Street. The victim did not seek immediate treatment, but later went to the hospital for care for her wounds. She was treated and released.

This is an active investigation while officers continue to search for evidence and gather statements. No names are being released at this time.

The two suspects taken into custody are described as:

#1: 36-year-old male from Menasha

#2: 38-year-old male, last known address in Neenah

Suspect #1 was transported to Winnebago County Jail for a probation hold. Suspect #2 was taken to Theda Clark for medical clearance, and then booked at the Winnebago County Jail for a probation hold and for possession of heroin.

Charges requested through the District Attorney's office may include Robbery, Burglary, and Substantial Battery.
