Re: Update on Missing Person: Kyle Blohm

At about 12:42 p.m. on Sunday, August 9 the Oconto County Sheriff's Office was notified that Kyle Blohm's truck had been located. A group of bear hunters found the vehicle in a wooded pine plantation that is county forest in the Town of Bagley, about 3 miles north of the village of Suring.

An Oconto County Sheriff's Deputy responded and verified the vehicle as Kyle Blohm's red Ford Ranger pick-up. The deputy then began checking the area around the truck and located the skeletal remains of a person.

Oconto County officials are working to positively identify the skeletal remains.

Kyle Blohm, who was last seen on August 8, 2014, was the subject of a significant search effort by family members and law enforcement. He disappeared mysteriously, and apparently took several personal items with him. All search efforts proved fruitless.

While the identity of the skeletal remains is not yet confirmed, Kyle's family members understand the implications of the discovery. They wish to release the following statement, prepared by Kyle's father, Mike Bogan:

It is with heavy hearts that we must bring you the sad news that Kyle Blohm was found on Sunday August 9th. Kyle was an outstanding son, father, brother, nephew, cousin and friend. He will be greatly missed by all who loved him. We ask that you please give the family some privacy to grieve at this time. Thank you to all that have supported us throughout this difficult time. Please keep us in your thoughts and prayers.
