Re: Missing Adult – Kyle Blohm - Update

Kyle Blohm is listed as a missing person by the Neenah Police Department. He was last seen on August 8, and has had no known contact with anyone since August 12.

Despite police investigation, use of social media, and distribution of Missing Person fliers in the community and through the news media, there is no further information on Kyle's whereabouts or welfare.

The Neenah Police Department and Kyle's family are partnering to renew a request for information, and to plead with Kyle to at least make contact with someone so people know he is okay.

Below are two direct messages to Kyle: one from Kyle's parents, and one from the Neenah Police Department.

Message from parents-

Kyle:

It has been 33 days since we've known you were okay. I know what you're going through and the pressures that go along with it. I'm telling you that it's normal and it's understandable. Please send word to me that you are alive and in no danger. I love you more than anything and I'm concerned for your well-being. A lot of people are worried sick and just want to know you're okay. Whatever we need to do to make things right for you, we will do with no questions. You can move back in with me and I will assist in caring for your beautiful daughter as much as I can. I spoke with your former boss and he says you can come back to work for him at the same wage you were getting at your last job. You can go back to school, if that's what you want. Lots of people are lined up to help you get through this. I pray that this message finds you in good health and that you reach out to me to let me know you're alive and well. If you still want time to figure things out, we will all back off. There is nothing to be ashamed of or embarrassed about. You did what you thought needed to be done.

Message from Neenah Police Department-

Kyle:

We hope you are okay and that your absence is fully of your own choosing. Until we know that for sure, we will continue to expend significant resources on your case.

It is not against the law for an adult to disappear, if that is what he or she wants to do. It is very painful for family and friends, of course. It also puts a burden on the investigating agency and the community as a whole. People feel less safe in Neenah when there is an unresolved missing person case like this. We plead with you to make contact with someone so we know you are okay. You can call the Police Department if you wish, or use any form of communication you are comfortable with. We do not need to know where you are. We just need to know you are safe.

Kyle drives a red Ford Ranger with Wisconsin plate JA4344 and a unique honeycomb grille.
