2016 Summer Volleyball Leagues Forming



Leagues are Co-ed and play on Tuesday or Thursday nights at the Neenah Outdoor Pool on S. Park Ave.

B-level play * sixes league (3 women & 3 men) Semi-strict, call line and net violations and illegal hits.

Leagues will play on the sand court within the Neenah Pool complex. The court has lights. The complex has a concession stand, sand play area (for small children), zero depth pool, water slides, and a diving board.

Six players maximum on the court, 4 minimum. However, must turn in a roster of 8 players minimum, to use as subs and avoid forfeits. See rules for details on acceptable line-ups.

Leagues follow the National Federation (High School) rules, along with various Parks & Rec Home Rules. Available online.

Free Swim For Players

All players listed on the team roster will be allowed free swimming from 6-8 PM (weather permitting) on their league night. All players must check-in at the admissions counter when arriving. (Family members - living in the same household may also swim free.)

Player Eligibility

Players 16 years of age and older are eligible to play in the summer leagues.

Spectators

Spectators (non-paying, which includes children) may watch the games from inside the fenced volleyball area, but must remain within this volleyball court area (sand area). Spectators are to check-in at the admissions counter when arriving. See above on free swim for family members.
