

2016 - KICKBALL MANAGERS' NOTES

Playing on Memorial Park Diamond #1. One League of 7 teams. 10-inch ball will be used. Game balls are provided by Neenah Parks & Recreation.

Schedules

- Games will be played at Memorial Park, 1131 Tullar Road, Neenah. (First diamond when entering the park from Tullar Rd.)
- The season will begin next week, August 24. You will play everyone once. Since there is an odd number of teams, one team will have a bye each week. If your team is not listed to play, you have the bye for that week.
- Games cancelled during Parks & Rec office hours, due to weather, will be posted on the cancellation page of our web site and on the Neenah Parks & Recreation Department's Facebook page. PLEASE DO NOT CALL OUR MAIN OFFICE NUMBER. If games are still on as of 4:30pm and it rains/storms between 4:30pm & your game time, teams must verify at their diamond if games are still being played.



Search Neenah Parks & Recreation

- Make-ups (rainouts) will be scheduled at end of the season. Make-ups will be posted on the website on the below link. Only if the rainout occurs at the end of the season (short notice) will managers be contacted by phone.

- Schedules can be printed from the city's web site or picked up at your game diamond. It is your responsibility to inform your players of game times and diamond site.
- **Adding Players to your roster**
Players may be added to the roster throughout the season. Individual player form must be completed and turned into the city hall Parks & Rec office, prior to playing. Individual forms can be found on our web page and can be mailed, dropped off or emailed via a pdf.
- **Home Team**
Team listed second on the schedule is considered the home team. Must use appropriate dugout.

OVER

- **League Champion**

The best win/loss record determines league champion. First place ties will be played off at the end of the season. Second place ties will not be played off. First place receives a team plaque & individual player t-shirts.

- **Grace Period**

A team's failure to field a team within 10 minutes, after the scheduled game, time will result in a forfeit. Teams that do not have enough players to start will be granted a 10-minute grace period. The game time will begin running (60 minutes) at game time. If the player(s) arrive during this 10-minute period the game will start (minus the time off the clock) with opponent winning 5-0.

- An umpire will be working the games.

Score verification procedure

- Each team is to designate someone (one person; either yourself or another player) to keep track of runs, for your team only.
- After each ½ inning, the official will turn toward the offensive bench to verify the number of runs they recorded verses what the official has recorded.
- Official will keep track of the score on a white board – hanging on the backstop. We don't want this to be a time consuming task – just a quick score verification.
