**Re: Missing 6-year-old child**

Neenah Police responded to a call of a missing 6-year-old boy at Riverside Park at about 4:35 p.m. today.

Officers immediately began searching the area and soliciting help from others in the park. There was a possibility the boy may have been playing near the water, so Neenah-Menasha Fire/Rescue responded to assist with water search equipment and personnel. Gold Cross Ambulance also responded in case they were needed.

Officers and volunteers searched the park area while Fire/Rescue personnel searched the near edges of the water. A reverse 911 system was activated through the Winnebago County Sheriff's Office to alert area residents to watch for the missing child.

After a period of time, Neenah-Menasha Fire/Rescue personnel found the child in the water. He was immediately transported by Gold Cross Ambulance to Theda Clark Medical Center. His condition is unknown at this time. He is a Neenah resident.

The Neenah Police Department wishes to express their sincere thanks to the many agencies and citizens who selflessly threw themselves into the search effort to find this little boy.

We anticipate releasing additional information on Wednesday, August 27.
