



AN ORDINANCE: By Public Services & Safety Comm.
Re: Renumbering & Amending Code §4-95(e)(2) as Code §4-95(f) relating to "Class A" Liquor Licenses for business whose main source of income is nonalcoholic sales by requiring display of liquor and wine be restricted to a separate room in the business.

AN ORDINANCE

The Common Council of the City of Neenah, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 4-95(e)(2) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Neenah is renumbered as Section 4-95(f) and amended by deleting the stricken language and adding the highlighted language to read as follows:

- (f) ~~No~~ A "Class A" liquor license ~~shall~~ may be granted to ~~any~~ a business whose main source of income is nonalcoholic sales related (example, grocery stores, drugstores, variety stores) provided that the display of beverages authorized to be sold by a "Class A" liquor license on the premises occur in a room separated from the rest of the business with a separate checkout and outside and inside entrances capable of being closed during hours when sale of intoxicating liquor is prohibited. Sales of beverages authorized by a "Class A" liquor license may occur at any sales register of such licensed business notwithstanding the restriction on the display of such beverages, provided such sales are processed in accordance with the requirements of Wis. Stat. ch. 125.

Section 2. Severability. In the event any section, subsection, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance. It is the legislative intent of the Common Council that this ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal provision had not been included or any illegal application had not been made.

Section 3. Repeal and Effective Date. All ordinances or parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
