AN ORDINANCE

The Common Council of the City of Neenah, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 2-167(a) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Neenah is amended by deleting the stricken language and adding the highlighted language to read as follows:

- (a) *Composition.* The Plan Commission shall consist of the Mayor, who shall be its presiding officer, the Director of Public Works, a representative of the Park & Recreation Commission (or alternate representative who shall be counted for quorum and voting purposes only if the representative was unavailable) appointed by the Chairman of the Park and Recreation Commission ~~(or in his absence, the Vice Chairman who shall serve as an alternate)~~ for a one year term, an alderman, a member of the Board of Education who is a resident of the City and three residents.

Section 2. Section 2-169(a) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Neenah is amended by deleting the stricken language and adding the highlighted language to read as follows:

- (a) *Composition; organization.* The Park and Recreation Commission shall consist of ~~eight~~ nine members, appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by a majority of all the members of the Council. One of the commission members shall be a representative from the Common Council. The term of office of each member shall be three years, ending on December 31, except for the representative from the Common Council whose term shall be one year, ending on the third Tuesday of April. All members of the Commission shall serve without salary or other compensation. A majority of such Commission shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

Section 3. Severability. In the event any section, subsection, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent

provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance. It is the legislative intent of the Common Council that this ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal provision had not been included or any illegal application had not been made.

Section 4. Repeal and Effective Date. All ordinances or parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
