Re: Vehicle vs. Bicyclist Collision

Neenah police officers responded to a call of an injury accident on Campbell Street near Kraft Street at about 8:15 a.m. this morning.

Investigation showed that a 6-year-old boy was riding his bicycle to summer school. His father was driving slowly alongside him in a vehicle, talking with him.

At some point, and for unknown reasons, the boy lost control of the bicycle and fell to the ground, colliding with the vehicle.

Gold Cross Ambulance responded and transported the child to Thedacare Regional Medical Center in Neenah.

The boy's injuries appear to be serious, but his condition is unknown to us at this time.

The family, who will not be named in order to protect the identity of the child, has requested to not be contacted by news media.
