Parks provide a sense of place for many of our citizens. All kinds of parks are important as a place to gather, celebrate, mourn, or connect.

DID YOU KNOW

- The City of Neenah has 25 parks
- The oldest park is Green Park (The Green) established in 1843 (That's older than New York City's Central Park!)
- There are 6 heated shelters and 10 seasonal shelters available for rental.
- Oakhill Cemetery is considered a park and is said to be the second oldest municipal cemetery in continual operation.
- A majority of benches and a lot of the trees in the parks are in memory / honor of someone.
- Doty Cabin, the historic home of James Duane Doty is part of the park system and is open to visitors June through Labor Day
Noon – 4:00PM daily.

- City Map or GPS Device to find your way from park to park


