RECOMMENDED FOR PASSAGE

AN ORDINANCE

The Common Council of the City of Neenah, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Neenah Municipal Code, Sections 26-152(15), 26-178(15), 26-199(13), 26-220(13), 26-237(9), 26-303(10), of the Zoning Code are hereby repealed in its entirety and is recreated to read as follows:

Sec. 26-152(15). Standards

Minimum shoreyard setback, 50 feet for a principal dwelling or use and accessory structures or uses. Boathouses are excluded from the shoreyard setback requirements.

Sec. 26-178(15). Standards

Minimum shoreyard setback, 50 feet for a principal dwelling or use and accessory structures or uses. Boathouses are excluded from the shoreyard setback requirements.

Sec. 26-199(13). Standards

Minimum shoreyard setback, 50 feet for a principal dwelling or use and accessory structures or uses. Boathouses are excluded from the shoreyard setback requirements.

Sec. 26-220(13). Standards

Minimum shoreyard setback, 50 feet for a principal dwelling or use and accessory structures or uses. Boathouses are excluded from the shoreyard setback requirements.

Sec. 26-237(9). Standards

Minimum shoreyard setback, 50 feet for a principal structure or use and accessory structures or uses.

Sec. 26-303(10). Standards

Minimum shoreyard setback, 50 feet for a principal structure or use and accessory structures or uses.

Section 2. Severability. In the event any section, subsection, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance. It is the legislative intent of the Common Council that this ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal provision had not been included or any illegal application had not been made.

Section 3. Repeal and Effective Date. All ordinances or parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
