1	When the green arrow is not working going from Main St to Commercial St.	
2	The streets are not plowed curb to curb. The snow bank is 2-4 feet into the street from the curb.	The congestion I see the most is Winneconne eastbound turning north on Commercial. In the morning I turn on Church, but sometimes turn on Isabelle due to the backup. Also, at the end of the day there is often a backup on eastbound Wisconsin Ave at Commercial St that goes past Church St. The cars will often try to cross the intersection on the yellow but not get all the way across; and then will block traffic heading south on Church St. until the light changes at Commercial.
3	When turning left onto Commercial St from Wisconsin Ave, there is rarely a green arrow. Especially during some of the busy times such as 4:30pm. Also, for those who walk downtown, the walk signs for the crosswalks do not last long enough. You aren't even halfway across the street and the do not walk sign is already up.	In the Church St lot, the gate to go past 4th floor is ALWAYS broken. Due to this, people who should not be parking there are constantly parking there. Also, on weekends especially in the winter people go up to the top floor to slide around in their car.
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5	turning onto Wisconsin from parking ramp towards stop light....very congested and backed up	
6	The intersection of Main and Church streets; traffic on Main traveling East block intersection so that when the traffic light is green for cars facing South wanting to turn left onto Main (East), they cannot turn left and fit into traffic on a green light, busses coming from the South turning right onto Main (East direction) also prevent this. This is between 4:30 PM and 5:30 PM.	
7	Going from the Church Street Ramp to turn left onto Wisconsin is usually incredibly congested. I usually have to go down a few streets so I can make it to Commercial (north bound) so I do not feel as if I am contributing further to the congestion.	It may be beneficial to have a green arrow going left out of the Church street ramp area to go East on Wisconsin. Many drivers are not able to turn left there during the current light duration as there are many people crossing the street there. An arrow would be helpful to clear some of the congestion there and then allow people to walk after the arrow is completed.

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8	The parking ramp is located in a spot where there is only one way to get out of the area. Because of that there is always a back up of cars. At the end of the day the people traveling on main st have a complete disregard for the light and will sit in the middle of intersection preventing the cross traffic (coming from the ramp) ability to go. Also the light headed away from the ramp only had two lane. One allowing a right turn only and the other allowing a Left turn and straight. The left lane is the one that is not able to turn keeping the people who just need to go straight from moving. It is awful and everyone knows it.	I think there should be another option for exiting the parking ramp area. Also I think there needs to be less cross traffic or more lanes so that traffic can continue to flow.
9	The lights are never long enough for people to turn left. People block the road on red.	
10	Coming out of the parking ramp between 4:30 and 6:30 is always congested. It takes forever to get out of the parking ramp and through the first light. There are times when the intersection is completely blocked and traffic is at a stand still because there is traffic backed up from the main street light and people get into the intersection and have no where to go!	
11	The left turn arrow to go to the Church Street ramp lets maybe 3 cars through before it turns off. When the cars are backed up around the corner to Main St, this is totally unacceptable! I have had to wait for three traffic light cycles before I can actually turn left to get to the ramp. That takes extra time when I could be going up the five, six, seven, etc levels to park.	You should have more parking ramps in the downtown area.
12	Lack of turn lanes. Duration of green vs red light. Pedestrian crosswalks are poorly placed on N. Commercial Street.	Major tenants need safer and better accessibility to parking/crosswalks.
13	Turn arrows are inconsistent (I feel they should be "on" during key times of day)	I don't understand why the City parks its snow removal machine and piles the snow within the Alta portion of the ramp. Alta needs those spots more than Plexus and it would make available a few more crucial spots (and get people off the street lots).
14	The intersection of Main and Church. Pedestrians stopping cars from turning and drivers/cars on Main blocking the passage on Church. They literally will go into the intersection when they know they can't pass through.	
15	Leaving from work there is too many traffic lights within a short distance that back up traffic from all directions.	

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16	The light on the corner of Wisconsin Ave and Church street. The light on Church only lasts 20 seconds or so.	It's very hard to left onto Wisconsin ave from the Church street ramp because employees are crossing the street and your stuck in the middle of the street when the light turns red.
17	There was always a bottleneck at the intersection of Wisconsin Avenue and Church Street when I would leave the parking ramp at 4:30. Because of all the traffic, it's very difficult to turn left onto Wisconsin Avenue, to head toward Commercial Street. Sometimes it's lucky if one car can make the turn, which backs up traffic well into the ramp.	
18	Leaving the parking ramp and turning left is awful.	
19	Main st traffic could be routed towards Columbia st and not downtown which would ease congestion.	There are two lanes at the intersection of Wisconsin Ave and Chuch St facing south on Church. The right lane should be for trafic heading south or turning right towards Main St. as the way it currently is set up traffic backs up into the 3rd and 4th floors of the parking ramp at peak times such as 4:30PM and 5:00PM.
20	The corner of Commerical and Wisconsin, is a very frustrating and dangerous intersection for pedesterians.	
21	I come from 41 N on main st and turn left on church st to pull into the ramp for Alta parking and my only issue is that more than once I have almost had an accident at the base of the bridge right before affinity where the right lane is supposed to veer right and a lot of times they don't and just whip into the left lane. Sometimes right where I am and I have to hit the brakes so they don't sideswipe me or they whip in front of me right at the last minute again causing me to brake hard.

31	North Church Street leading out of the Alta parking structure and the Plexus parking lot should have three lanes to help with congestion. There should be a left turn, a right turn and a lane for people trying to go straight on N Church Street. Because the right lane is right turn only, the left lane gets really backed up and if there is congestion on Main and Commercial, you have to wait 2 or 3 lights to go straight. Additionally, the lights on Main/Commercial and Main/N Church St should be more in sync, because there is a large back up that happens as a result of the Main/Commercial lights and it negatively affects the Main/N Church lights. One of the locations I've found this to be a problem is on N. Wisconsin Ave. where cars rarely yield for pedestrians using the cross-walks outside of the stoplights (this includes the cross-walk by Abraham Lincoln, the crosswalk between Church Street and Commercial street and the cross-walk between the Neenah Centers and the Holiday Inn. The worst of which would be the cross-walk by the Market Place as vehicles seem to have more difficulty seeing pedestrians given the number of cars parked along the street. The second location would be on Winneconne Ave where pedestrians are often running through the roundabout crosswalk to ensure they get through safely. My assumption is that drivers are attempting the roundabouts much too fast in attempt to beat the car they should be yielding to in combination with the statues etc that block drivers turning left from effectively seeing pedestrians attempting to walk across until they've made it around the object obstructing their vision.</p>	<p>As an additional comment, while not specific to Downtown Neenah, the area between Starbucks and Little Caesars seems to become particularly congested throughout the day. I notice this when arriving to work (around 8:00 am) and when leaving to go home (around 4:30 pm). When arriving to work, this area often becomes congested due to the number of individuals waiting in line for the Starbucks Drive-through.
