# Neenah-Menasha Fire Rescue

## Temporary Firework Stand Regulations

The following requirements of Neenah-Menasha Fire Rescue, the authority having jurisdiction shall be met to have a Fireworks Stand to sell fireworks within the City of Neenah and/or Menasha.

1. A permit for a fireworks stand must be applied for and issued through the City Clerk Office in the City of Neenah. Vendors are required to notify NMFR and have an onsite inspection with approval from the Department prior to fireworks being offered for sale in either City.
2. The sale of fireworks, at a fireworks stand, shall fully comply with Wisconsin State statutes Chapter 167 under safeguards of person and property section 167.10 which prohibits the sale of fireworks requiring permit including items that explode or leave the ground.
3. All applicable 2015 Fire Codes IFC Chapter 56 and 2012 editions of NFPA1 Chapter 65/11 including and not limited to the following considerations:
  - a. No Smoking Signs shall be posted at each entrance or within 10' of every aisle.
  - b. Open flames, including any smoking, shall not be permitted within 50' of the stand.
  - c. Sales areas shall be 20' from any building or combustible.
  - d. Generators shall be 20' away from the stand and shall not have more than 5 gallons of fuel at any given time.
  - e. One Fire Extinguisher (2A:10BC) minimum for areas less than 200 sq ft. and shall not exceed a travel distance of 35'.
  - f. Retail Stands must have a minimum of two exits. The most remote point to an exit shall not exceed 35' of travel distance.
  - g. Tents must be constructed of flame retardant material and a certificate of affirmation shall be available.
  - h. Electrical Systems must be physically protected from damage by pedestrian or vehicle traffic. Extension cords must be in good working condition, grounded when serving ground appliances, and rated for the use while directly plugged into an approved receptacle.

In the event that the Fire Chief or designee feels that a violation has occurred or an unsafe condition is present, the vendor will cease all sales and/or be issued for citation for violations.
