Press Release - 9/29/2017

On 09/29/2017, at approximately 4:45 p.m., Neenah Police responded to a local business for a 27-year-old male who was not conscious and not breathing. When officers arrived on scene CPR was in progress. Officers administered the drug Naloxone, and were able to revive the male subject. He was transported to a local hospital for treatment.

On the same date at approximately 5:55 p.m., Neenah officers responded to a different local business for a 24-year-old male who was not conscious, was turning blue, and was only slightly breathing. Officers administered two doses of Naloxone and the male became responsive. He was also transported to a local hospital for treatment.

Naloxone is a drug that counters the effects of an opioid overdose. Neenah officers administered the life-saving drug using Evzio auto-injectors, obtained through a grant offered by the manufacturer.
