Re: Train/Pedestrian Collision

At about 7:14 p.m., on Sunday, December 10, 2017, Neenah Police and Neenah-Menasha Fire Rescue were dispatched to a call of a train vs. pedestrian collision in the 100 block of North Lake Street, near the parking lot of Herb and Dolly Smith Park.

The preliminary investigation indicates a 28-year-old Menasha man was struck by a southbound Canadian National train at that location. Gold Cross Ambulance transported the pedestrian to ThedaCare Regional Medical Center – Neenah with significant injuries.

The Neenah Police Department is working cooperatively with the Village of Fox Crossing Police Department and the Canadian National Police to thoroughly investigate the incident. Anyone with information about the collision or events leading up to it is encouraged to contact the Neenah Police Department.

The pedestrian's identity is not being released pending notification of family members.
