# PRESS RELEASE

On Monday, 9/10/18, Neenah Police Officers responded to the 600 block of Main Street for a weapons complaint where a gun had been fired at another person. Responding officers secured the area around the incident location, and safely evacuated residents in the immediate area.

Through witnesses, Officers found out no one was injured and confirmed a disturbance with a firearm had occurred between a 30 year-old male and an 18 year-old male. They had an argument and the 30 year-old pointed a gun at the younger male. The two men fought over the gun and a shot was fired during the scuffle.

The Neenah SWAT Team safely took the suspect into custody and he is being held at the Winnebago County Jail. Charges of Endangering Safety by Use of a Dangerous Weapon, Going Armed While Under the Influence of Intoxicants, and Disorderly Conduct related to a Domestic Incident were filed with the District Attorney's office.

This was an isolated incident and there is no further danger to the community involving the parties in this case.
