RE: Vehicle versus Pedestrian Accident

At approximately 6:57 A.M. on October 14, 2019, Neenah Police officers responded to a semi versus pedestrian accident on Main Street at Western Avenue.

Officers arrived on the scene where a 14 year old Neenah High School student was being treated by Gold Cross Ambulance and Neenah/Menasha Fire Department. In speaking with several witnesses and reviewing in-vehicle dash camera footage from the semi, the juvenile ran across the road into the side of a passing semi. Officers were able to speak with the alert juvenile before being transported to a local hospital.

Per Neenah Police Department's policy and procedures, Neenah Police Department investigates all accidents involving injuries in our city. If anyone has any information pertaining to this incident, please contact Lieutenant Wagner at 920-886-6000.

As a reminder, it is important to look both ways before crossing the road. Please wear lighter clothing to make yourselves more visible in the early morning hours. When available, please use the flashing amber lights to assist you at designated crosswalks.
