3. Material: 12ga., 304 polish stainless steel and cut colored glass. Pricing on stainless steel could effect the price quoted stated on this data sheet.
4. Artist will handle welding and supervise the welding crew for quality control.
5. Computerized cad drawings/schematics and pattern cutting.
6. Total fabrication est. time, two and half months.
7. Site prep work by the city of Neenah at Arrowhead Park. Artist to assist.
8. Delivery system: semi tractor-trailer (flatbed), crane, loading, unloading and setting in place.
9. Site location will be the new Arrowhead Park in Neenah, WI. The city to provide site prep work for sculpture (concrete base platform wiring and lighting).
10. The budget includes all the material and labor to deliver a finished product to the city of Neenah.
11. The total cost for the sculpture called "The Promise of the River" is est. \$75,000.00. **Note:** The price may increase from the date of this document until all the funds have been raised, including the cost of stainless steel at that time.
12. **Note:** The city of Neenah will be the depository for all the funds raise and will oversee the dispensing of funds raised for this project.
