

## WELCOME TO SUMMER BEACH VOLLEYBALL-2020 STARTS THURSDAY, JUNE 11

- League will play at the Neenah Pool Sand Court (court within the pool complex) on Thursday evenings.
- Game schedule is posted on the city's web site: www.neenahgov.org/departments/parkandrec/leaguesports/volleyball
- ❖ Each team will play 8 matches with starting times of 6:00, 6:45 and 7:30PM. Home team has serve in first and third games and away team has choice of side for first and third games. Switch sides, in third game, after 13 points has been reached by a team.
- There is NO GRACE PERIOD-be on time for the start of your match.
- First team to reach 25 pts wins. No win by 2. Rally scoring will be used. (Points awarded after each illegal hit or violation, regardless if serving.) Each game counts. Team with the best win-loss game record wins the league. First place receives individual league championship t-shirts.
- ❖ Please make sure you have enough players to play each week. Minimum number to start a game is 4, which 2 HAVE TO BE WOMEN.

## RULE 8 - SPECIAL RULES FOR CO-ED

## Section 1

There must be at least 3 women on the playing court at all times. (Exception: If only 4 or 5 players, 2 women are okay.)

- Serves that hit the net and go over (let serve) are legal & playable.
- Enter the facility through the main (front) entrance. You must check-in with the admissions staff-tell them you are there to play volleyball. Go through the appropriate locker room and out to the court. All players listed on the team roster will be allowed free swimming from 6-8 PM (weather permitting) on league nights.

- Spectators (non-playing, which includes children) may watch the games from inside the fenced area, but must be within the volleyball court area (sand area) or the tables adjacent to the volleyball courts. <a href="Players">Players</a>' children will be allowed to swim in the pool or play in sand play area, while team is playing in NPRD VB league. 7 year olds and under must be accompanied by an adult in the pool or in the sand play area. The pool staff are not babysitters. All spectators should check-in at admissions counter when arriving.
- You may add players to your roster throughout the season. Before playing, an individual form (available at the city hall Parks & Rec. office or on ww.neenahgov.org) is to be completed by the player and turned into the City Hall Parks & Rec office.
- Rainouts: Parks & Rec will <u>not</u> be calling managers, if matches are cancelled, due to weather. <u>After 2:00 PM</u>, you may call a cancellation line at 886-6068 or the Neenah Pool at 886-6080 or visit the web page. <u>Please do not call for an update until after 2:00 PM</u> and please do not call our main phone number. If we cancel the matches before 4:00 pm, we'll post it on FACEBOOK, as well. *Note: The pool may be closed, yet volleyball games could still be playing.*
- Make ups will be post on the website, along with the weekly standings. If you believe there is a discrepancy with the standings, please call our office to discuss.
- Leagues follow the National Federation (High School) rules, along with various Parks & Rec Home Rules. Rules are posted on the web page. Standings will be posted on www.neenahgov.org.
