<p>Special Instructions for Voting in a Partisan Primary</p> <p>In the Partisan Primary:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You may vote in only ONE party's primary. If you choose a party, votes cast in that party will be counted. Votes cast in any other party will not be counted.
