

TDORA stands for Temporary Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area and will be introduced to Downtown Neenah this summer! This would provide for beverage service from licensed establishments within a designated TDORA boundary (see map) during these events so guests could purchase drinks to be enjoyed on the concert grounds. In short, a visitor attending one of these music events could purchase a beverage from a licensed establishment within this area to be consumed onsite at the concert. Approved containers would include plastic cups (no glass) and businesses will have TDORA stickers for them as an approved carry out drink.

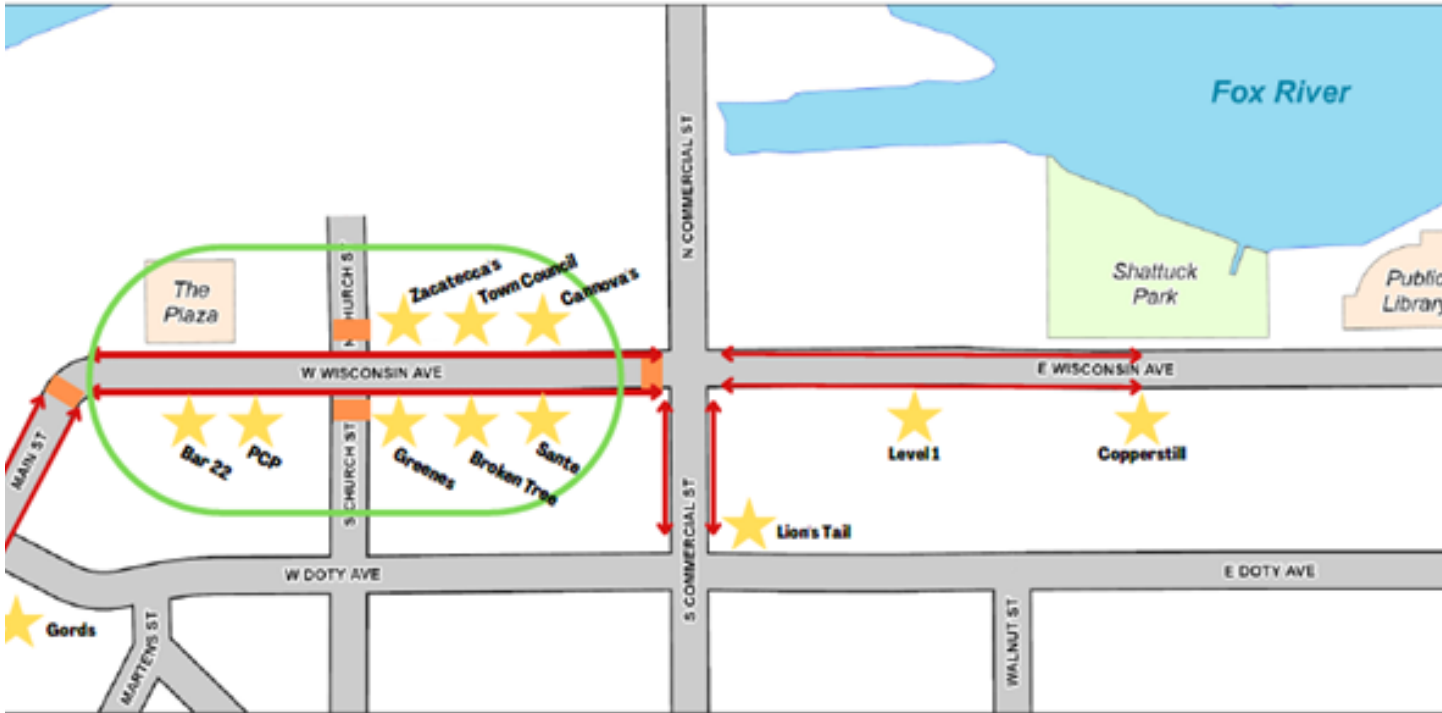
How To:

- Are you 21 or over? Yes? Explore downtown Neenah and visit one of the fine licensed establishments listed below during the street concerts.
- Purchase the beer/wine/cocktail of your choosing. It will be served to you in a plastic cup or can (no glass allowed). Container must be marked with approved TDORA sticker!
- Responsibly enjoy the beverage from your favorite establishment which enjoying the free concert on Wisconsin Avenue—a perfect evening out!

Rules:

- Please no carry ins.
- Beverages may not be carried from one establishment into another.
- No beverages may be carried outside the mapped boundaries below.
- Dispose of cups and cans in onsite trash receptacle.
- Do not drink and drive—all regular beverage consumption and operating laws do apply.

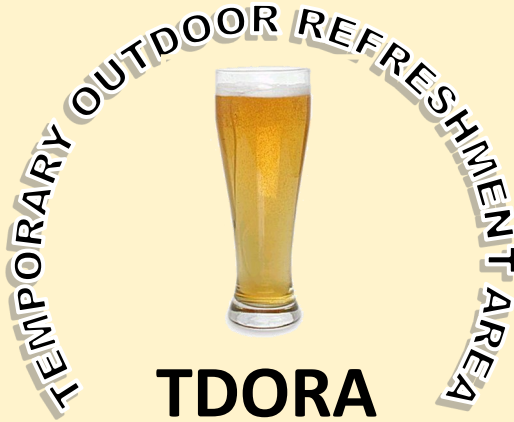

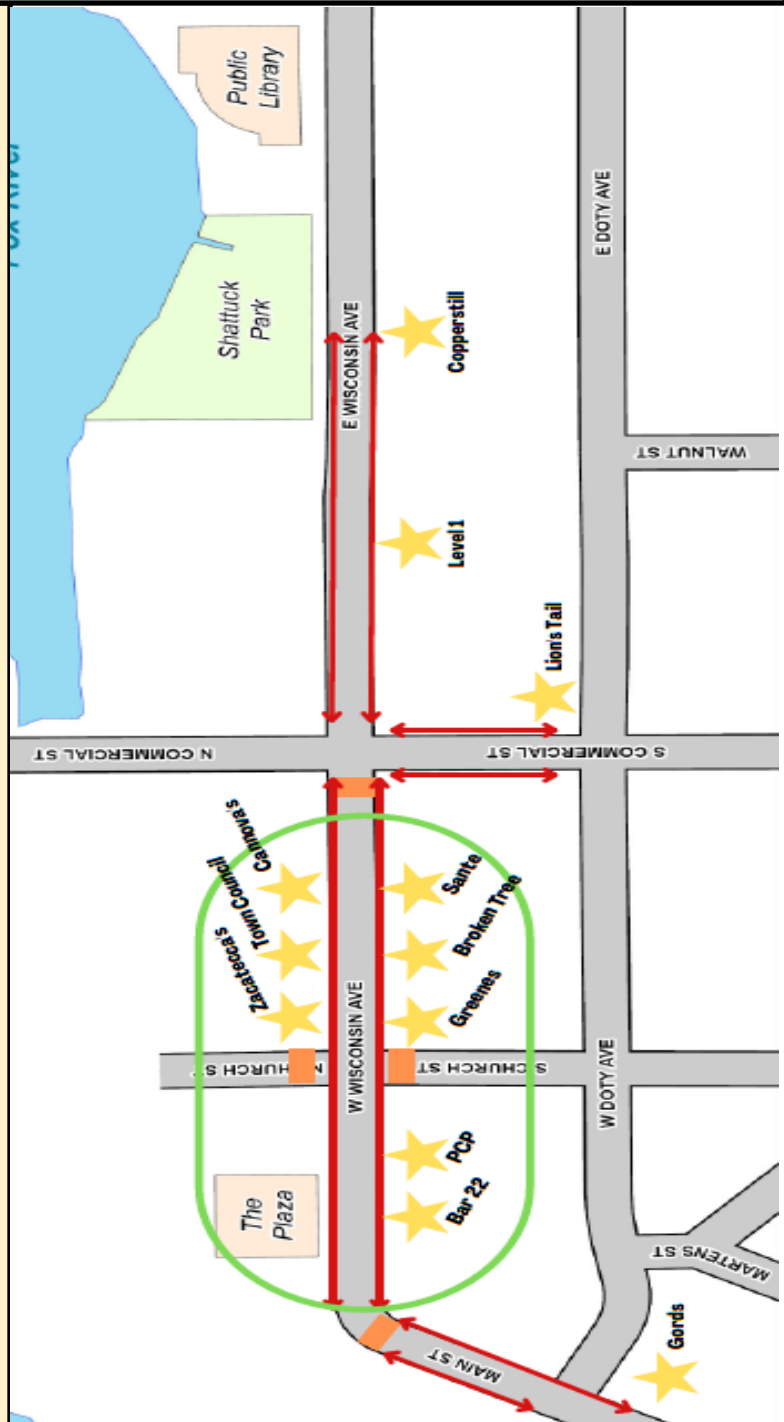
Temporary Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area

- ◆ Patrons must be 21+ to purchase or consume alcohol.
- ◆ TDORA beverages should be purchased at participating bars and restaurants.
- ◆ Drinks should be in unbreakable transparent or semi-transparent containers or their original packaging; however, no glass is allowed.
- ◆ Stay inside the TDORA boundaries.
- ◆ Dispose of cups in trash receptacles located throughout the downtown.
- ◆ Finish your drink before entering another establishment.
- ◆ TDORA expires at the conclusion of the event.
