#### RIVERSIDE FOUNTAIN HEALTH & SAFETY ISSUES

The City of Neenah is advising the public that playing in the fountain at Riverside Park may result in serious injury or illness. Warning signs have been installed informing the public that playing in the fountain is not allowed.

Water in the fountain is not treated and sanitized to the same degree as a swimming pool. The water may contain bacteria, viruses, or parasites, such as Cryptosporidium or Giardia, which can cause serious illness. Children are at the greatest risk because they are most likely to play in the fountains, and they most easily spread pathogens due to wearing of diapers, drinking the water, and/or hand-to-mouth behaviors.

Please enjoy the sound and beauty of the fountain. Don't put your children or yourself at risk by playing in the fountain or drinking fountain water.
