Cedar St. Belmont Ave. Belmont Ct. Stevens St. (Winn Hts - Belmont)	The contractor is scheduled to continue water main construction on Cedar Street and Belmont Avenue and begin sanitary later and water service construction on Cedar Street and Belmont Court.	The contractor is scheduled to continue sanitary sewer and water main construction on Belmont Avenue and Stevens Street and continue sanitary lateral and water service construction.
Bayview Road. (S, Park – Bayview Lane)	Rest Period. A rest period is required by the contractor to allow the sewer trench backfill time to settle prior to street construction.	Rest Period.
