<b>Cedar St. Belmont Ave. Belmont Ct. Stevens St.</b> (Winn Hts - Belmont)	The contractor is scheduled to continue water main construction on Belmont Avenue/Court and Cedar Street and continue sanitary lateral and water service construction. <b>Bayview Road.</b> (S, Park – Bayview Lane)	Rest Period. A rest period is required by the contractor to allow the sewer trench backfill time to settle prior to street construction.	Rest Period. <b>Quarry Lane</b>	The contractor is scheduled to finish sanitary sewer main construction and begin water main construction.	The contractor is scheduled continue water main construction.
