	<b>June 9 – June 14</b>	<b>June 17 – June 21</b>
<b>Cedar St. Belmont Ave. Belmont Ct. Stevens St.</b> (Winn Hts - Belmont)	The contractor is scheduled to continue storm sewer construction on Belmont Court, continue sanitary sewer construction on Stevens Street, and begin water main construction on Stevens Street.	The contractor is scheduled to continue sanitary sewer and water main construction on Stevens Street.
<b>Bayview Road.</b> (S, Park – Bayview Lane)	The contractor is scheduled to relay a portion of the storm sewer.	The contractor is scheduled to begin concrete curb and gutter repairs.
<b>Quarry Lane</b>	The contractor is scheduled finish sewer lateral and water service construction and begin Water main Construction on Reed Street.	The contractor is scheduled to finish Water main construction and begin storm sewer construction.
<b>E. Doty Avenue</b> (Commercial – Pine)	The contractor is schedule to continue storm sewer construction between S. Commercial and Oak Street. Oak Street will be closed when constructing storm sewer in the intersection.	The contractor is schedule to continue sanitary sewer construction East of Elm Street.
<b>Jewelers Park Dr</b>	The contractor is scheduled to finish concrete driveway apron construction, continue rough grading the terraces.  <b>During construction the roadway will be closed to through traffic and open to businesses/residents.</b>	The contractor is scheduled to pave the lower lift of the asphalt on the North end of the project.
