



PARK SHELTER RENTAL INFORMATION

- Neenah Parks & Recreation has 4 heated shelters available for rental year-round.
- Park shelter rentals must be made online or in person in our office (scan the QR code to the right for online shelter rental instructions). Payment is due at the time of rental along with the completion of the rental agreement. Rentals will not be accepted over the phone or via email. You will need an account to rent a shelter online. Contact our office to create an account. Please note that accounts may take up to 2 business days to be activated, so please plan ahead by getting your account early!
- Reservations must be made at least 10 days in advance and can be made up to one year in advance.
- Fees are non-refundable. If you must cancel, call ASAP. If that shelter is re-rented on the same date, you will receive a refund.
- Shelter hours are 9:00AM-10:00PM, with the exception of the Whiting Boathouse, which is 9:00AM-Midnight.
- Alcohol is **NOT** allowed in any park shelter in the City of Neenah, with the exception of the Whiting Boathouse and its fenced patio area.




