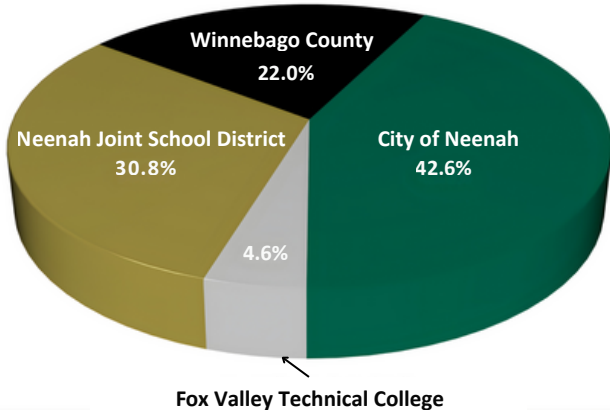

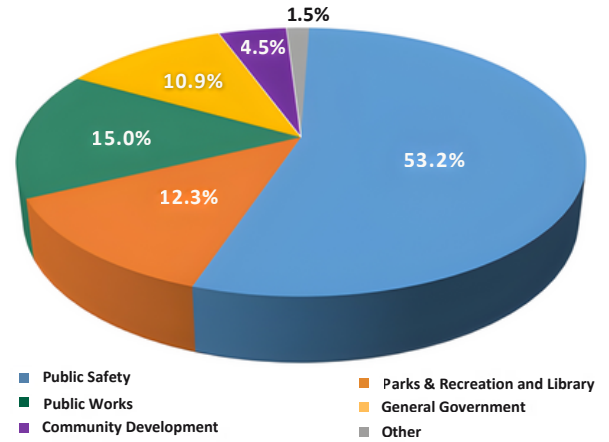

Additional Information

RECEIPTS: If payment is made by mail and you would like a receipt, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope.

RETURN PAYMENTS: A \$35 fee will be charged for a returned check and a \$20 fee for a returned online payment.

LOTTERY CREDIT: If you DO NOT have a Lottery/Gaming credit on your tax bill, you may still be eligible. To qualify for the credit, your primary residence must be in Wisconsin and be owner occupied on January 1 of the tax year. This is a State of Wisconsin program that is facilitated by the City of Neenah. Forms are available in the Treasurer's office, city of Neenah's website or you can use the DOR's online portal at: www.revenue.wi.gov/forms/lottery

2026 Pet Licensing

All dogs and cats over 5 months of age are required to be licensed in the City of Neenah. The fees are: \$10 for altered pets and \$15 for unaltered pets. A \$5 late fee will be imposed if the license is purchased after March 31, 2026.

Proof of a valid rabies certificate will be needed or no license will be issued. Payment and an application can be submitted on the City of Neenah's website. If submitting online, the license and tag will be mailed when processed.



2026 Fire Permits

Fire permits can be obtained on the City of Neenah's website (Finance Department) or in the office. An electronic application is filled out and the email confirmation is the permit. If you do not have an email address a receipt will be printed for you, this can be done in the office or mailed in with a self-addressed stamped envelope. The cost of a 2026 fire permit is \$20.



Recycling Fee

In response to declining state grants and recycling commodity sales, the recycling fee began in 2012 to cover a portion of the city's cost for yard waste collection, the drop-off site and curbside recycling collection. The recycling fee has been set at \$55 for 2026. Recycling continues to be an effective means to reduce city costs. The city saves over \$75,000 in landfill tipping fees annually because of residents recycling. Recycling is required by the state statute, is environmentally responsible and saves the city money.

Property Fraud Alert

What is Property Fraud Alert: A free notification service offered by Winnebago County that warns homeowners when a document is recorded with their name on it in the county's land records.
