





Doty Park Phase 1 Shoreline Stabilization & Improvement Project


Problems

- The current wood shore wall (installed 38 years ago) has failed.
- This is creating sink holes that are unsafe for our park guests.
- It has allowed soil erosion into the Fox River Channel.



Solutions

- Install concrete block walls in the internal channel.
- Naturalize the shoreline along the Fox River.
- Create specific access points for fishing and viewing.



Project Key Points

- 750' of shoreline along the Fox River will be naturalized through the installation of prairie matting, seeding, and plantings.
- 3 fishing/viewing outcroppings will be installed along the Fox River
- 1362 linear feet of concrete block will be installed in the internal channel complementing the existing bridges.
- Historic bridges (built 1925) will remain untouched.

Project Outcomes

- Improved park guest safety and enjoyment
- Stabilized & improved shoreline resulting in:
 - increased erosion protection from ice, wind, and wave action
 - reduced erosion and run-off
 - improved water quality
- Improved habitat for birds, pollinators, reptiles, and fish
